The Chromatic Scale

#= Sharp b= Flat

Or "The Musical Alphabet"

A A#/Bb B C C#/Db D D#/Eb E F F F#/Gb G G#/Ab A

- The letters in the musical alphabet only go to G. After G, everything just repeats back to A.
- B and C. as well as E and F don't have a sharp or flat between them.
- Sharp and flat notes actually sound the same, but go by two different names.
- You can start this scale on any note and the pattern will remain the same. Imagine it as a big circle.
